The following paragraph was read by Board President Susan Tolles during open session of the February 5, 2007 meeting:

"Tonight the Board has discussed in closed session real estate matters with District representatives. I would like to continue some of that discussion in open session. I would like to emphasize that the Board has not and is not taking any action during this meeting. It is my sense, given our discussions with District representatives, that the Administration is not proceeding with any action to gain access to any of the tracts owned by members of the Grumbles family, and that the District is looking at other land options on which to locate future District facilities. Dr. Kirk: Would it be possible for the Administration to put on the agenda for the February 12 Board Workshop an item for discussion and action related to the rescission of the resolution that authorized the Administration to pursue judicial assistance, if necessary, to gain access to the Grumbles' property?"
